Nearly 100 young men and women participate in W-L's crew program, which began in 1949 and includes rowers from H.B. Woodlawn. W-L rowers have won a number of national championships plus England's prestigious Royal Henley Regatta in 1969, and several have gone on to Olympic competition. This past season several W-L boys' and girls' boats won medals at local and regional regattas.
